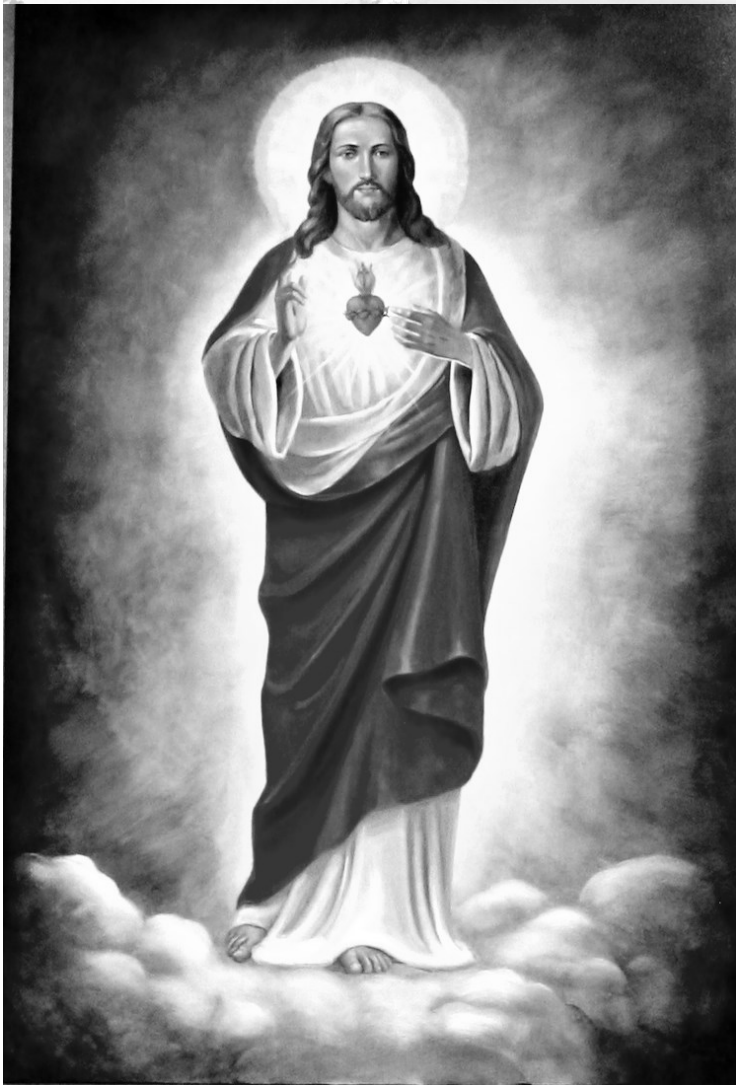

Spirituality and post-COP21 engagement in light of *Laudato Si* and the Pope's call to action on the environment".
