THIS WEEK IN THE PARISH

The Dwelling Places of God

Peter's suggestion of making three dwelling places would have been very appropriate before Jesus came to earth. He was suggesting they build places equivalent to the Jewish Tent of Meeting, which was a sanctuary or a tabernacle for the Presence of God. (See the accompanying image.) At the Transfiguration, there were definite indicators of God's presence: a bright shining light and a cloud out of which God's voice sounded. A cloud led the Israelites through the wilderness by day and a bright pillar of fire (Shekinah Glory) by night and the Jews built the Tent of Meeting as a dwelling place for God, the God of the Old Covenant, whenever the cloud or pillar of fire stopped moving.



After the Transfiguration when God said, "Listen to my Son," he wasn't chiding Peter for getting it wrong. He was indicating to them all that the Dwelling Place of the Most High God had now shifted. He was no longer going to dwell in a physical Tabernacle because Jesus himself was now the Tabernacle of God or God's dwelling place. Jesus was the New Covenant and the Tabernacle was no longer a static structure. It was the Holy Tent of Meeting who went down the mountain with his disciples. After Christ's Resurrection and after the Holy Spirit was sent, the Tabernacle or Tent of Meeting became the dwelling place within each one of us. There are Tabernacles in our churches but the cloud and light of God's presence goes with each of us wherever we go. That is God's New Covenant gift to us. We are no longer tied to physical spaces to know the safety and protection of God. He now accompanies each one of us as we navigate through our own particular wildernesses and deserts.

Listen to what Paul said in Ephesians 2:19-22: [You are] members of God's household, having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, the Messiah Jesus himself being the cornerstone. In union with him the whole building is joined together and rises into a holy sanctuary for the Lord. You, too, are being built in him, along with the others, into a place for God's Spirit to dwell.


