Jesus appeared to the disciples, said "Peace be with you", breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit." Then he said that bit about whose sins they forgive are forgiven and whose sins they retain they are retained.

But scripture scholars have discovered that the second part doesn't say, "Whose sins you retain..." The word 'sins' is not in the second part. The literal translation of the Greek in the second part is, "whomever you hold are held fast." I'm not going to use up space talking about the accusative case and the genitive case, (or trying to make you think I know anything about Greek grammar!) but the Greek word for retain (krateos) in this passage is in the genitive case which gives the word krateos a gentle action rather than a forceful one. So, what Jesus really said was, "those you hold fast (embrace) will be held fast (embraced) by God and they will continue to be held fast (embraced) by God."

What a beautiful commandment! What a superb consequence of receiving the powerful breath of God, the Holy Spirit, especially for the disciples who had already been forgiven much and therefore were called to go out and forgive much. They were also sent to embrace and to hold fast, (cherish even) the beloved of God.

We, too, have received the Holy Spirit. We, too, have been forgiven much and we are also called to go out to forgive and embrace the beloved of God. And I do hope you realize that there is no one who is not a beloved of God; there is no one who is not worthy to be forgiven and embraced. There are no exceptions.

Pentecost is about true power. It's not the power to accuse, judge and hold responsible, not even ourselves. It is the power we have been given to love, forgive and hold fast (embrace).

Can we unleash this power on the world?




