Highs And Lows

“Humility is not thinking less of yourself, but thinking of yourself less,”
(C.S. Lewis. Mere Christianity)

In today's Gospel where Jesus tells the guests at a banquet to choose the lowest place instead of the place of honor, it is obvious that he wants his habit of choosing the lowest place to be emulated.

But choosing the lowest place takes a certain amount of *je ne sais quoi* to do it in a way that builds us up spiritually. “*Je ne sais quoi*” literally means “I don't know what.” It is something indefinable, something hard to pinpoint and we need to explore this one aspect of Jesus's hard to define qualities. Jesus didn't choose the lowest place because he didn't think he was worthy or because he was too polite to put himself in the limelight or because he was scared of being humiliated by being asked to vacate the place of honor. He chose it because he had absolutely no need of the highest place. Low place, high place, it was all the same to him. In order for us to make that choice in the same spirit Jesus did, we only need one thing: to know how beloved we are to God. That should be our total reason for taking the lowest place. If it's not, we may be engaging in false humility.

When we know without a doubt that we are loved by God, we have already found the highest place. We have found Home and there's no need, no pressure inside, to have anyone else recognize our value. It's the sweet spot. It's sweet because, in having no need to be honored or recognized, there is no disappointment or dissatisfaction. When we don't know how beloved and honored we are in the Kingdom, there is always the need and desire to find that next honorable mountain top, that next place of recognition. It can be addictive and it never fills us up. Jesus knew that.

Find the sweet spot.
