


First Sunday of Advent

Advent prompts us to prepare for Christ's coming by examining how we are living our life in light of the gospel and how well our actions reflect our response to Christ - Paul says we must "abound in love for one another," especially the most vulnerable in our community.



Bishop's Appeal Update

Spirit of Hope - Healing & Reconciliation

Parish Goal: \$51,000

Actual: \$35,652.37 Gifts Received: 120

Commitment to the Bishop's Annual Appeal will help the parish, and build relationships toward healing and reconciliation.


