

THIS WEEK IN THE PARISH

A few words from our Pastor:-

Today, not many of us worry about worshiping false idols. The days when people worshipped Ba'al or Zeus have long since passed. However, idols are more than just statues or myths. They can be anything that we prioritize above the love of God in our lives. Idols then are rarely unattractive. Even if we do not love the idol, we love what it brings. Not many of us *love* our jobs and everything about them, but we love the blessings that they appear to give. That is also why it is so hard to give up our idols. We believe them to be responsible for giving us so much. Sadly, they take more from us than they give.

Giving up our idols is like giving up an addiction. We can get fearful and go into withdrawals. We can even lash out on our loved ones. Like an addiction, idols give us the illusion of power, control, and confidence and often at the expense of the poor and vulnerable. The biggest idol is the self. God loves us all, but we depend on his love. To suppose that we can rely on our strength is the deepest illusion and the greatest cause of injustice in our society.

"God chose what is weak in the world to shame the strong." These words from St. Paul underline the beautiful words of the Beatitudes: "Blessed are the poor in spirit." To be a Christian means to embrace our own fragility because God's "weakness" is greater than all human "strength".


