

#### A few words from our Pastor:-

This coming week we will celebrate two of my favorite celebrations in the Catholic Church: All Saints Day (Nov. 1) and All Souls Day (Nov. 2). Each day will have the regular 9am Mass and a 6pm Mass for those who work during the

On All Saints Day we celebrate that God calls ordinary people to do extraordinary things. Paradoxically, it is often the case that the most extraordinary of tasks are simple things done well. Mother Teresa said that if she were only called to peel potatoes, then she should strive to peel those potatoes beautifully. This day also commemorates all of those saintly people who brought beauty and light to this world, but may have not received their reward or recognition in this life.

All Souls Day is the day we pray for the repose of the souls of all those who have died. Although I love All Saints Day, I particularly love All Souls day. When we pray for those who have died, we are also asking for their healing and reconciliation with God and with others. It would be best if we could say those parting words with our loved ones while they are with us, but usually out of fear or of confusion, we may miss our chance. Being a Catholic is about striving to follow Christ, while remaining realistically aware that second, third, or 77th chances are also options. Together, participation in these two celebrations summarize this mystery better than any bulletin notice ever could. God Bless
