# 27th Sunday in Ordinary Time



... from the beginning of creation, 'God made them male and female.'

(Mark 10:6)

The Gospel for the 27th Sunday highlights the contrast between God's ways and human ways. The Pharisees ask Jesus about divorce, something that has affected many, whether directly or indirectly. ... It is one of the most painful of many types of separation that can occur between two persons. It affects not only the divorced man and woman, but also their children, relatives, and friends.

God's relationship with each one of us, in contrast, is one of never-ending, complete faithfulness, revealed in the total self-gift of the Cross. God remains faithful even when we are unfaithful. ... He seeks to draw us into a union with Himself so close that we "are no longer two, but one flesh." This love between God and an individual person overflows into the lives of others, inviting them into the communion of love, echoing Jesus' words: "Let the little children come to me; do not stop them."

## Canadian Bishops Announce \$30M National Financial Pledge to Support Healing and Reconciliation Initiatives

27 September 2021 – Ottawa – The Bishops of Canada, as a tangible expression of their commitment to walk with the Indigenous Peoples of this land along the pathway of hope, are making a nation-wide collective financial commitment to support healing and reconciliation initiatives for residential school survivors, their families, and their communities.

With a target of \$30 million over up to five years, this will include initiatives in every region of the country. The commitment will be achieved at the local level, with parishes across Canada being encouraged to participate and amplify the effort. Bishop Raymond Poisson, President of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB), expressed hope that these efforts will support meaningful projects across Canada and make a significant difference in addressing the historical and ongoing trauma caused by the residential school system. Funding for projects will be determined locally, in consultation with First Nations, Métis and Inuit Peoples in each region. The Bishops of Canada have committed themselves to develop national principles and strategy, timelines, and the public communication of these collective initiatives this November. Bishop William McGrattan, Vice President of the CCCB, articulated the importance of working together with Indigenous Peoples on local goals, timing, and distribution of funds.

A <u>national apology</u> was issued by the Canadian Bishops on Friday, 24 September. In the weeks and months ahead, the CCCB will continue to provide updates on this work, as part of a long path towards healing and reconciliation.

The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB) is the national assembly of the Bishops of Canada. It was founded in 1943 and officially recognized by the Holy See in 1948.
