

Be Here Now

Pay attention, people! Will Jesus come like a thief in the night...or like a babe in the night?

Advent is a time to sharpen our attention with the understanding that the coming of Christ was, is, and always will be, a very subtle intrusion into our lives. The often overwhelming clanging gongs of Christmas preparation can dull our senses and cause us to miss the reality of what it means that Christ has come and is coming all the time. He will not announce himself with trumpets. The star of Bethlehem was not flashing neon sign with an arrow pointing to the manger. People like the shepherds, who were familiar with the still silence of the night, and the Magi, who had hearts that contemplated so they could hear the sound of light and answer its call, were given access to a tiny infant born in the midst of the dark confusion and noise of the world.

But how do we sharpen our attention? Be here now. Attend to the present moment as often as you can. Pull your thoughts away from future concerns and past wounds to live in the moment where God resides. You will find yourself pulled away time and again because living in the moment is not easy. It's hard to believe that the past and the future are never resolved by constantly chewing on them and all they do is bring unnecessary noise and confusion to an already confused and noisy life. Sure, you need to make plans but the mistake comes when you live in those plans and all the imagined variations of them. Make a plan and then come back to the present and put the plan in God's hands.

If Jesus did come like a thief in the night, what would he steal from you? All the worries you've stacked up and hoarded? All the resentments that fall out of overstuffed cupboards? If he did come like a babe in the night, what would he bring to your home? The innocent sweetness of a child who can only exist in the moment?

Thief or babe, be there for him.



St. Francis Xavier 3 December

St. Francis Xavier was born April 7, 1506 in Xavier (Javier) Castle near Sangüesa, Navarre, Spain, died December 3, 1552 on Shangchuan Island, China. He was canonized on March 12, 1622. St. Francis Xavier was the greatest Roman Catholic missionary of modern times, establishing Christianity in

India, the Malay Archipelago, and Japan. He was one of the first seven members of the Society of Jesus, or Jesuits, under the leadership of St. Ignatius of Loyola. Francis was ordained a priest on June 24, 1537.

On March 15, 1540, Francis left Rome for the Indies. Francis spent the next three years on the southeast coast of India among the Paravas, simple, poor pearl fishers, baptizing about 20,000. Using a small catechism he translated into Tamil, Francis travelled from village to village instructing and confirming them. Shortly after, on the southwest coast, he baptized 10,000 Macuans in the last months of 1544. In the fall of 1545, Francis travelled to the Malay Archipelago, to Malacca; founding missions among the Malays and headhunters in the Spice Islands, Moluccas. In 1548, he returned to India, to develop the College of Holy Faith into a centre to educate native priests and catechists for the diocese of Goa which stretched from the Cape of Good Hope, Africa, to China.

On August 15, 1549, Francis travelled to Japan. His first letter from Japan revealed his enthusiasm for the Japanese: "the best people yet discovered." By 1551, Francis left 2,000 Christians from five communities in Japan to his companions. On December 3, 1552, Francis died on the island of Sancian, Shangchuan, off the Chinese coast, as he attempted to secure entrance into the country.


