I would like to thank Angela who has concluded her term as Pastoral Council chair after a few years of service. I would also like to thank Natalia for graciously accepting the nomination of her fellow PPC members to be our new PPC chair. We have made the exchange of roles before the busy Easter season where we will also be holding our annual PPC elections.

I would also like to thank Bob and Ross as their terms as Finance and Maintenance chairs are coming to a close.
