

There's a pretty clear message in today's Gospel: don't get hung up on material possessions. Once again Jesus is teaching about the value of travelling light so there must be something important about it.

My husband and I had to clean out the suite of a deceased man who was a hoarder. I understand that hoarding is a mental illness but I think hoarding on some level is a characteristic of most of us. There are certain possessions we find very difficult to throw away: good boxes or plastic containers, old keys or pens, personal papers, books, old electronics, old tools... the list goes on and on. Cleaning a hoarder's space was an "in our faces" illustration of how easy it is to go from having a few unnecessarily stuffed storage areas and drawers, to having possessions take over one's life and one's peace.

We keep stuff because we might need it later. It might come in handy. And that way of thinking is actually a challenge to our daily faith. As long as we hold on to anything to ward off future need or inconvenience, we feel more in control and more self-sufficient. Those two things are really not healthy goals in the spiritual life because they hinder our complete trust in God, especially in this moment where God dwells. Control and self-sufficiency are future considerations and God is not in the future – not the futures we tend to imagine and live in anyway.

The less we hang on to stuff, the freer we become to turn our eyes upon our God of provision. There is no sin in having possessions; the critical question is, "Can I easily let go of this if necessary?" If the answer keeps coming up, "No! I can't let this go," then it's time to take stock of the whys of our possessions. They may be keeping us from saying to the Lord,

"Your love and your grace are enough for me." These are prayers God always answers.




