

Dear Parishioners,

Thank you all for your generous donations in 2017. Our collections in 2017 were \$256,214.00. 5% more than in 2016.

After providing for asset amortization and other nonoperating items we had a net income of \$7,780.00.

As at December 31<sup>st</sup> 2017 we had \$25,423.08 in our bank account.


