

A few words from our Pastor:-

This Thursday is the March for Life. If you can make it, I would encourage you to attend. I would also encourage you to attend if it is difficult. We will be closing our Parish office on Thursday to participate in the march. It is important that we remind our legislators that we have not bowed or consented to the devaluation of human life in our country. Canada is meant to be better than this. Any attempt to dominate and devalue human life, legal or not, is gravely evil. However, this does not mean that we must devalue the people who, culpably or not, have consented to these legalized evils.
