THIS WEEK IN THE PARISH

A few words from our Pastor:-

This Thursday is the March for Life. If you can make it, I would encourage you to attend. I would also encourage you to attend if it is difficult. We will be closing our Parish office on Thursday to participate in the march. It is important that we remind our legislators that we have not bowed or consented to the devaluation of human life in our country. Canada is meant to be better than this. Any attempt to dominate and devalue human life, legal or not, is gravely evil. However, this does not mean that we must devalue the people who, culpably or not, have consented to these legalized evils. We must acknowledge that in our own day we are not much better than the Christians of old who engaged in unjust war, slavery, imperialism, communism, fascism, materialism, anti-semitism, or residential schools. They too had excuses. As we are ashamed of these past sins, we will learn to weep as God weeps over these injustices.

With this in view, God did not come into the world to condemn the world. He came to save it. He accomplished this through the forgiveness of sins. We do not condemn our society, politicians, and lawmakers. We must undermine the allure of evil with the joy of the Gospel. Celebrate the gift of life through the Sacraments. Aid struggling parents. Visit the lonely and the elderly. Forgive those who curse us. This we have been commanded to do in Christ Jesus.
