#### **100 Years of Loss**

The "100 Years of Loss" curriculum from the Legacy of Hope Foundation (in partnership with the Aboriginal Healing Foundation) will be facilitated by Fr. Dean Henderson for non-Indigenous People.

Fr. Dean, primarily through relationships with Yukon Tlingit, Vancouver Island Ahousaht, TS'ou-ke and Pacheedaht Peoples, is increasingly aware that non Aboriginal Canadians must learn the history of residential schools to better understand the need for our healing, and reconciliation with our brother and sister First Nation peoples.

Fr. Dean will also consider the written reflections of the residential school experience of two Catholic religious orders; one of which was submitted for the Truth and Reconciliation Commission.

This short course will be awareness building through lessons from history, experiential exercises and will have the goal of motivating desire for friendship through healing, justice and reconciliation.


