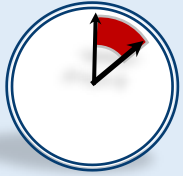

The Sadducees posing the question of which of seven brothers would be married to a widow in heaven after each of them had married the same childless widow was not so much a trap but a challenge to the logic of Jesus' belief in eternal life. They disputed his belief and they just wanted to show that his belief was logically silly. But don't try to outsmart Jesus with logic. His logic made a shambles of their line of thinking.

But what has that got to do with us? None of us are likely to challenge Jesus in a contest of theological logic, especially not over eternal life, which we all believe in.

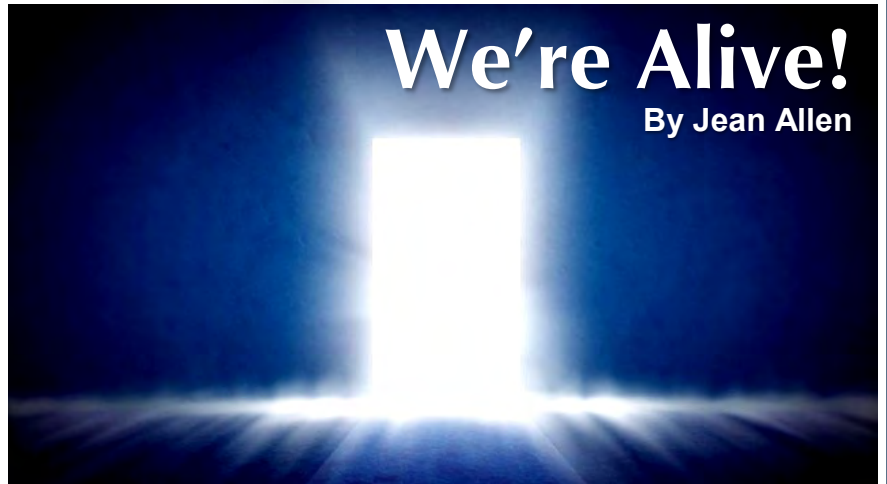
The beauty of this story is that it is a simple but stunning example of the outrageous hope Jesus brought to this world. Sometimes I think we know too much and ponder too little. After he spoke of God proclaiming himself as the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, Jesus said, "God is not the God of the dead but of the living, for to him all of them are alive." They were not alive to God because of their holiness for they all had deception, betrayal, failure and sometimes blood muddying their hands. They were alive to God because God was alive to them. In spite of their human weaknesses, God was the center of their lives; he was the one, in the end, that they kept turning to and trying to follow. Did they fail sometimes? Absolutely. Did they screw up and have to come to him for forgiveness, strength and mercy? Certainly. And that's what made them alive to God – not their self-created successes but their humility in knowing that, in the end, they needed God desperately and could not exist without him.

Therefore, for them, for us and for those who have gone before us, we now know that what this world glumly labels 'death' is nothing but a door that leads from darkness to everlasting light. We are alive to God! Wow! And it's not because we are so good.

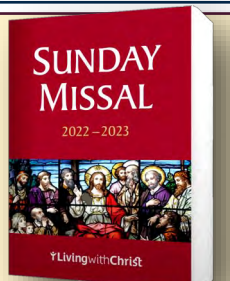
It's because He is.

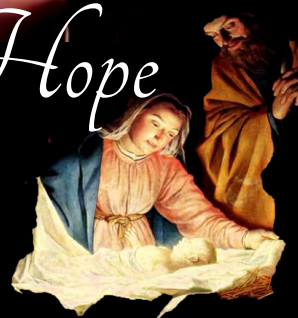

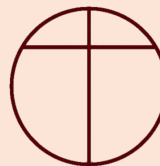
