* 1st Sunday of Lent | March 6th, 2022 *

The Rich Symbolism & Meaning in the Church's Liturgical Cycle that assists us in our journey of salvation.

Collecting blessed palms from the previous Liturgical Year, we use the symbol of the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem that begins Holy Week, and burn it to ashes for distribution on Ash Wednesday to begin the season of Lent in the next Liturgical Year. This reminds us that life is transient, and that we are on a pilgrim journey to eternity. The Lenten journey eventually brings us back to Holy Week, to collect the blessed palms again. Each gesture, symbol, and prayer in Sacred Liturgy is filled with purpose to focus our hearts and minds on God through each Church calendar as we live our daily lives.













The 2021-2022 Ordo (CCCB 2021, p 159) reminds us that the season and liturgies of Lent focuses on two themes: Baptism and Penance (reconciliation and conversion). Part of this sacred Lenten journey includes the preparation of catechumens for the celebration of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil. Lent also invites us as Baptized and Confirmed Catholics, through prayer, penance, and reconciliation during Lent, to prepare for the renewal of our Baptismal promises at Easter. All this, in anticipation of the highest point in the Church's calendar; the three-day memorial celebration called the Sacred Paschal Triduum, or the Easter Triduum that begins on Maundy Thursday and ends with the Easter Vigil on Saturday. To create the contrast on our journey to the light that conversion brings, the "Gloria" and "Alleluia" are not sung throughout Lent, flowers are absent from the Altar and its surroundings, and silence is observed to allow us to immerse ourselves in contemplation of Christ's Redemptive Sacrifice for us. This makes the proclamation and celebration of our Lord's Resurrection all the more glorious and triumphant. As St. Paul said: "If Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins." (1 Corinthians 15:17) Have a grace-filled and meaningful Lenten journey.

During Lent Silence will be observed before and after Mass.



Please also respect those who may be praying by observing silence in and around the church.

The Roman Missal Chants found on pp. 644 to 651 in the **Sunday Missal** will be sung during this season.


