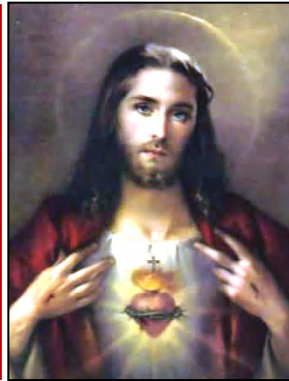

Circulation Theology

What happens when blood stops circulating through a body? It dies.

What did Jesus do right after instituting the Eucharist? In the Gospel of John, he showed us how to keep his blood circulating in order to maintain a healthy vibrant body: he washed his disciples feet and instructed everyone to do the same.

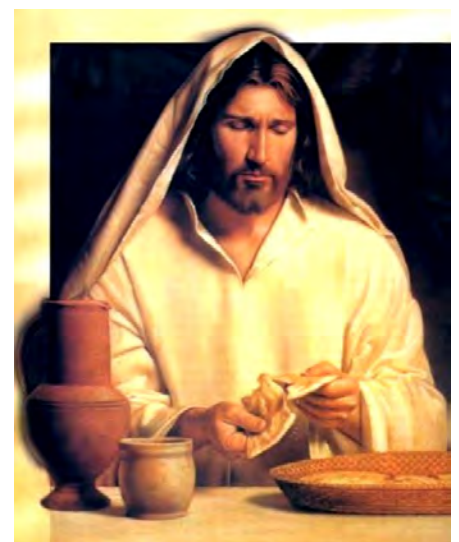
If we receive the body and blood of Christ but have no intention of maintaining a serving relationship with the rest of the body and if we treat the Eucharist as a private devotion, like a spiritual gas station that is solely for our own benefit, the whole point of the Eucharist is missed. If we do not receive in order to wash the feet of others around us, the circulation of life-giving blood encounters a blockage. If the blockage is severe enough, the body starts to lose energy and eventually die.

Jesus not only washed his disciples feet, he also went out to suffer and die in complete forgiveness, further demonstrating his call to us to serve and to allow his lifeblood to course freely through his whole body by acting in self giving love and forgiveness. This maintains a healthy spirituality in you as well as in the body of Christ around you.

Love. Forgive. Love. Forgive. Love. Forgive. Love. Forgive.

Get that blood pumping!

Apology and Commitment

The discovery of the remains of 215 children found at the former Kamloops Residential School shines a light on a painful tragedy for which words seem inadequate to express my profound sorrow. As we move through these long days of June, more light exposes the dark places of the residential schools era. The penetrating light of our Creator continues to search the hearts of all for the truth, and challenges us to a renewed commitment to listen and act.

On behalf of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Victoria, I apologize for the harm caused due to our complicity involved in the operations of the residential schools. I am committed to the process of healing, reconciliation, and education regarding this tragic history.

The archival records related to the two Residential Schools (Christie and Kuper Island) that were managed by the Diocese of Victoria were forwarded to the Truth and Reconciliation Commission (2008-2015) and our commitment to transparency remains firm.

We are committed to assist First Nations communities in the work of searching for loved ones who went missing at the residential schools in our Diocese.

We are committed to help facilitate mental health and counselling support for individuals and communities in our Diocese to help find the peace that comes from truth and justice.

We remember with profound sorrow the children who died and the members of their families who continue to grieve and all those who live with the trauma of Residential Schools. We continue to seek pathways of healing for all those on the journey of truth and reconciliation.

We are all interconnected and we have a responsibility to accompany one another in the circle of life. We humbly acknowledge the pain of the past and we accept responsibility for the role we have played in the history of Residential Schools. With the help of the Creator, the path forward is hopeful as we move forward in the light of a new tomorrow.
