#### A few words from our Pastor:-

Some of you may remember our attempts with the Cathedral and the Duncan Parish to receive a refugee family. After some initial disappointments due to restrictions imposed by our present Federal government, I decided to forestall updates until we had some reliable news. I am happy to announce that our team has been in contact with an Eritrean refugee with the hope of reuniting her with her family in Canada. This is an ongoing work and your prayers are appreciated, but we are close.

Also, we have begun exploratory work on our new confessional. You may notice that some supplies have been moved as the cupboards needed to be cleared. These moves are temporary so that our contractor can do his job. Finally, we have been in consultation with an audio company about what to do with our sound system. We have received a good quote to replace our failing receivers and monitors, but we are still concluding the preparatory discussions.

As Easter draws closer, let us make the most of this Lent to deepen our communion with the God who saves us.
