## No Fear

This Gospel passage can cause a bit of a gulp in our hearts when Jesus talks about the Master coming when least expected and finding his slave eating and getting drunk and beating up on other slaves. Getting cut into pieces, a beating and banishment are the upshot of that scenario.

But note how Jesus begins this lesson. He says, "Do not be afraid, little flock. It is the Father's good pleasure to give you the Kingdom."

Then he speaks of Kingdom qualities: being detached from your possessions, living in charity and love, building up treasure in heaven where your heart is. It is the Father's good pleasure to give all of this to us; these Kingdom qualities are gifts of grace and gifts for life.

Yes, Jesus goes on to speak about the misery of living outside of the Kingdom, should we choose to; by refusing God's graces and gifts, and not living in his presence. It's like being cut into pieces, not by God but by the cruelties of a fractured world. We are susceptible to being beaten by the slave masters of this world if we don't find our treasure and our refuge in the arms of the Father. It's a choice we're free to make.

As usual, when we hear a passage of scripture like the one for this week, if there is anything fearful in it, we latch onto that and forget the words of love and grace. We allow the fear to define who we think God is. But if it is God's good pleasure to give you the Kingdom, you can bet that he will do everything in his power to make that happen. Everything in his power! We don't stand a chance of being cut into pieces and forever lost.

Do not be afraid, little flock.
