

THIS WEEK IN THE PARISH

Reflection for the week

At the Transfiguration, the disciples hear a voice that hearkens back to Christ's baptism: "This is my Son, the Beloved; He enjoys my favour. Listen to Him." As Pope Francis has said, "We, the disciples of Jesus, are called to be people who listen to His voice and take His words seriously. To listen to Jesus, we must be close to Him, to follow Him. When we listen to the word of Jesus and carry it in our heart, this Word grows. The Word of Christ grows in us when we proclaim it, when we give it to others! And this is what Christian life is. It is a mission for the whole Church, for all the baptised." It was the grace of hearing God's voice that filled Abram with the conviction to go forth from the land of his kinsfolk to a completely unknown land. We can bear our hardships for the Gospel, because through the Transfiguration we have been given "the power of God who has saved us". The grace we need in order ot go where God directs us has been "revealed by the Appearing of our Saviour Christ Jesus".

New Temporary Church Guidelines

The emergence of the new coronavirus (COVID-19) is impacting people worldwide and has led to understandable concern among the faithful. Coronaviruses are thought to be spread mainly from person to person through close contact. Entrusted with the mission of Jesus to care for all the members of our community, parishioners are encouraged to observe the following:

- Stay home if they are sick or feeling unwell;
- Practice good hygiene, including frequent hand washing;
- Avoid hand-to-hand contact during the Our Father and the Sign of Peace;
- Ministers distributing Communion should use hand sanitizer before and after the distribution of Communion;
- Communion hosts should be received only on the hand, not on the tongue;
- The Precious Blood should not be distributed until further notice;
- Holy Water should be removed from the fonts;
- Celiacs and those with special needs are encouraged to consult their pastor.




