Dear Parishioners,


When I first came to this parish and delivered my first homily, I made a promise to not be an obstacle between you and God. And so now, I thank you for helping me to keep that promise. Let me also share the witness of the silent presence of Our Lady, who was present every day from the beginning of my time here. I arrived on the Assumption of Our Lady; and now, I am leaving on Mothers' Day. Another very significant detail is that I am leaving the parish on a Sunday that is the *World Day of Prayer for Vocations*. So I now have a favour to ask: that through her intercession, please pray every day for vocations.

Thank you from the bottom of my heart. It has been a most adventurous journey for me, and a most meaningful nine months that I have spent here with you, as your Pastor at Sacred Heart Church. You have all been so welcoming, kind, and gracious. I am sad to leave you, but happy that I was able to share these nine months with you.


I thank all the Ministry Coordinators and volunteers who made the celebration of the Eucharist throughout the months, and the celebration of Advent, Christmas, Lent, and especially the Sacred Paschal Triduum the best I have ever celebrated in my years as a priest. I am so very happy to also have been able to share the oldest Crucifix on the island with you on Good Friday. The Veneration of the Cross on that day, with you, was the most profound I have ever experienced. Thank you.

Before I go, I will remind you of the first thing I urged you to do; to read the Gospels, to give a moment of each and every day to listen to God by reading and listening to His Word in the Holy Bible. All the messages are there. All your answers are there. The meaning of life, and how to walk the path of your life as you journey to your eternal home with Jesus in Heaven. The Redemption story of God's Eternal Love is embedded in the pages of the Old and New Testaments. He is the One Person Who will never abandon you. He is the One Person Whom you can trust. Trust Him with all your heart. He is the One Person Who is greater than your sins. All He asks is, "Do you love Me?"

This brings me to my second encouragement to you. Meet Jesus in the Confession often. Always keep that connection. No matter how life bombards you with fear, abandonment, disappointments, temptation, and sin, He will always be by your side, waiting for you to seek His help. Turn to Him, and never, ever lose hope. Never despair. The Fount of Divine Mercy is always present and there for you. He is always by your side, and on your side, waiting for a deeper relationship with you.



Have a concrete and practical faith, too. Review the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*. Be like St. Philip, and be the best teacher and example to your family, your children, and your friends. Know the Sacraments, the tangible manifestations of God's Love on earth, and of His presence at every moment of your life's journey, from birth through to natural death. The Sacraments will strengthen and provide the Graces you need in your life's journey. Celebrate the Eucharist as often as you can. Meet the Lord in Mass – the most important highlight of your day, and your week. Through your example, vocations will come through the joy, service, and love that you share. This is all tied in and ensured perpetuity in the church through *The Code of Canon Law*. This governs the Church to ensure that we are always provided, cared for, and nourished by the Sacraments, and the celebration of the Holy Mass in all parishes around the world by her clergy.

Lastly, I would like to thank the staff and committees of Sacred Heart. You made my administrative responsibilities, daily and pastoral schedule, and the balancing of my time between the parish and my seminary lectures smooth and easy. Thank you. Thank you very much. Thank you with all my heart.

You are the parish of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. You bear a most sacred name to uphold. As I have hoped and intended when I started the First Friday Devotion to the Sacred Heart in September 2021, I encourage you to continue your devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and to celebrate the First Friday of each month to honour His Sacred Heart; the Heart of Love and Divine Mercy.

This is what your community, and your parish stands for, and it has been a privilege and honour to have been your pastor.

Trust in His Divine Mercy and Love, always. My prayers and blessings will always be with you.
