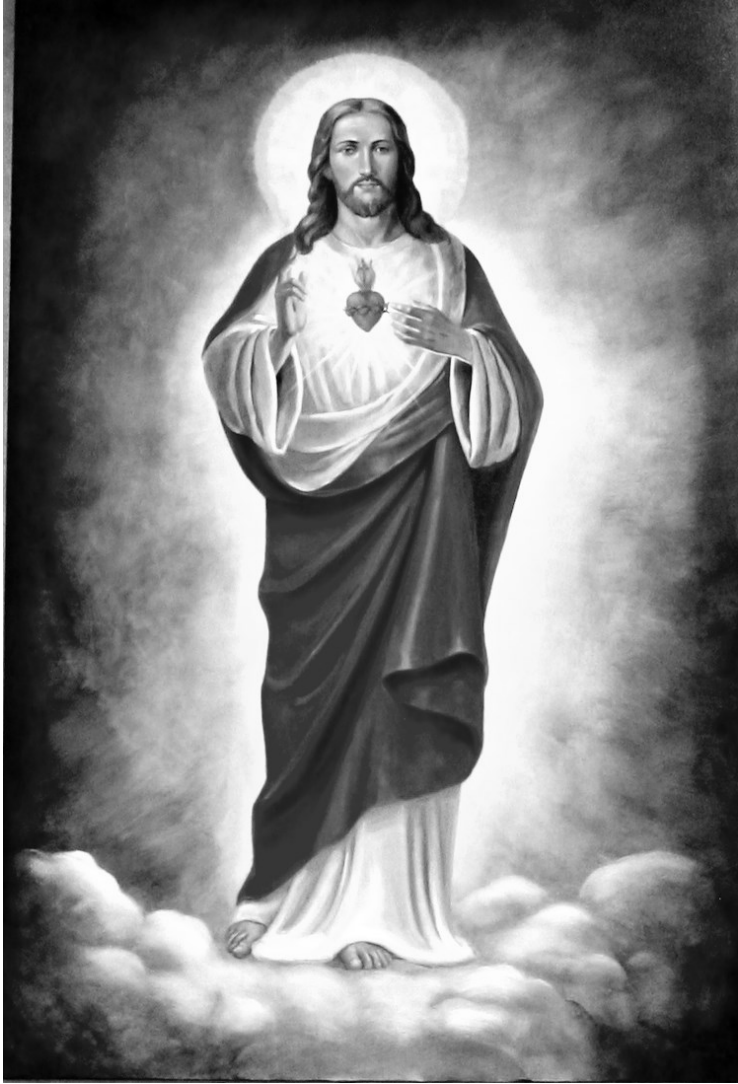

Development and Peace

In Syria, millions of civilians are struggling to survive the conflict. We have seen the images on TV recently of the suffering of the people in Aleppo.

Since the war began in Syria in 2011, more than 470,000 people have lost their lives and 13.5 million people are in need of humanitarian aid. In addition, 6.5 million people are displaced within the country, forced to flee from one place to another.

Since the beginning of the conflict, over four million people have fled Syria to seek refuge in Lebanon, Turkey, and Jordan. These refugees include some 1.7 million children. Recently, we have seen the flight of those trying to reach Europe. Faced with what the UN describes as “the greatest humanitarian challenge of our time,” we cannot remain passive.

Please sign our letter to the Prime Minister calling on the Canadian government to do everything in its power to protect civilians in Syria and to end the conflict through peaceful means. The letter is on the table in the foyer. You can read more on the website www.devp.org
