

#### THIS WEEK IN THE PARISH

#### A few words from our Pastor:-

Last week, I wrote about the sacramental character of the Church. The local Church (Diocese) is the People of God united in faith around the Bishop in the celebration of the Eucharist. The Parish is a faith community that shares in that communion with their local priest. This **hierarchical** structure is counterbalanced by the rule of **subsidiarity** (or locality). This principle of Catholic teaching is meant to preserve local freedom from centralized control. Eg. If a Parish can competently manage its own finances, then they should be left alone.

As each Parish should be able to operate as an independent cell, there are a few central governance bodies within each Parish community. Church law requires there to be a Finance Committee (PFC) to operate as a counterpoint to the priest. In this Parish, any purchase over a few hundred dollars requires PFC consent to prevent anyone from turning the Parish finances into a personal fund. Additionally, in Victoria, each cheque requires two independent signatures. For any purchase over \$10,000, the Parish must get approval from the Diocese. The PFC is also responsible for the Parish budget if (as in the present case) the priest is not competent to manage the books. Our Parish has also hired a bookkeeper to handle the books in a professional manner. The PFC is not designed to establish Parish goals or priorities, but to determine if the established goals are feasible.

This leads us to the Pastoral Council (PPC). Church law does not mandate a PPC, but it is highly encouraged. It consists of members selected to advise the pastor on the needs of the people: "What about parents? Children? The elderly? Immigrants?" It is this group that helps the pastor establish a vision for the Parish. However, unlike the PFC, if the PPC votes, it is a non-binding vote. It would be tantamount to saying: "Let the record show that we disagree with you, Father. "To go against such a vote, I would have to have a really good reason. So whereas the PFC has veto power, it doesn't propose; the PPC has no veto power, but it can guide the Parish's identity and mission.

These three structures, pastor, PFC, and PPC constitute a triad of checks. The PFC prevents the PPC and pastor from allowing their dreams to get ahead of them. The PPC calls the Parish to be attentive to the needs of the people -especially the vulnerable. It is the job of the pastor to bind these components of Parish life together and offer them to God in the Eucharistic offering. The priest enacts the presence of Jesus in the Church by receiving our gifts to God and giving God's gifts to the Church. If these governing structures fail (as all structures can fail), then the Bishop is called in to help. However, we should try to reconcile with our neighbours before we call the Bishop.
