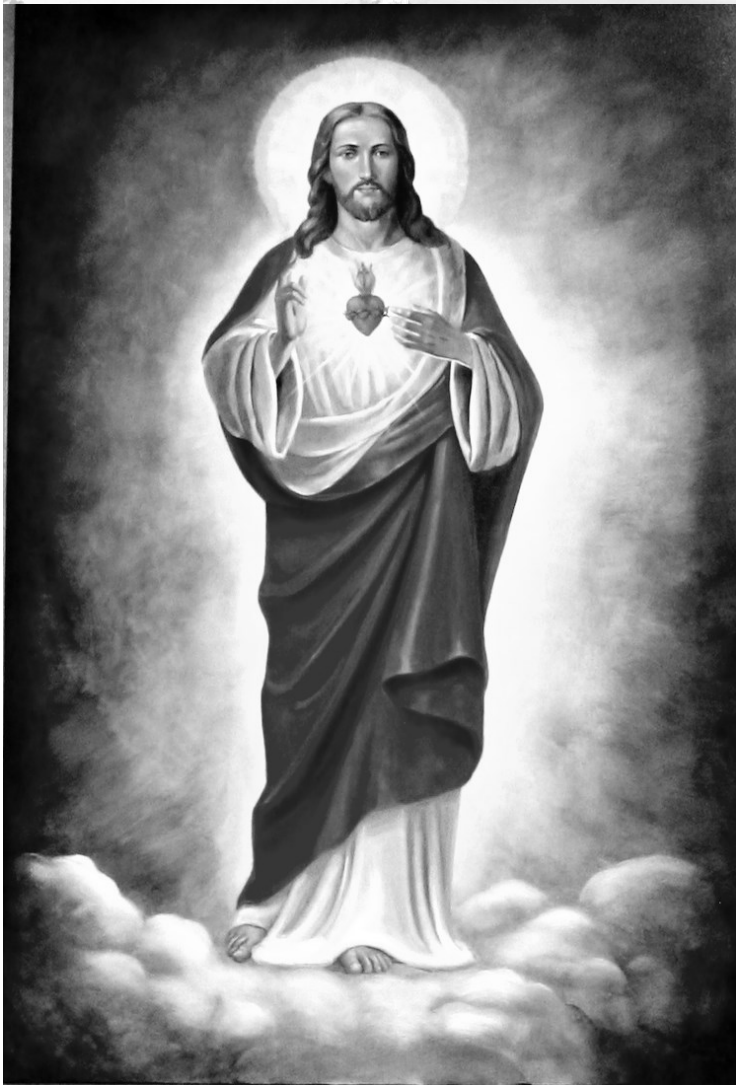

THIS WEEK IN THE PARISH

A few words from our Pastor:-

It is Holy Week!

This week we remember and are present at the mystery of Christ's Passover and our freedom from enslavement to sin and death. Admittedly, the meaning of this mystery is a little hard to process. That is why we are called to be present to this mystery through the Church's solemn celebrations. These celebrations put us at Christ's side as he entered Jerusalem, ate his final meal with his disciples, suffered anxiety in the garden, his arrest, condemnation, scourging, bearing the cross, his crucifixion, death, and descent among the dead. We also rejoice with him as his Resurrection brings hope to all those unjustly condemned and scorned. Most importantly, the Resurrection is not merely about the vindication of the righteous; it is about forgiveness towards the guilty.

It is not particularly interesting news that good people can suffer injustice. The Good News of this week is that God can turn our deepest dejection into a surpassing joy. In the midst of his Passion, Jesus consoles those who weep and forgives those who abused him because he is from the Father. By Baptism, God has promised himself to us. As long as we choose God as our ally, no one can truly be our enemy because no force in creation can separate us from our deepest hope.
