

## A few words from our Pastor:-

Last week, St James warned us to not be merely hearers of the Word, but doers of the Word. This is a call to action and to ministry. Ministry is more than simply a way to give back. It is a privileged opportunity to serve God in our neighbour. It is through this service, done in faithfulness, that we also grow in our knowledge of the Lord we serve. Catechists and teachers must deepen their understanding of the faith; those who visit the sick and the homebound learn care and respect for the vulnerable; those who minister in prisons have to learn mercy while maintaining clear boundaries. Having participated in all of these ministries at various times in my life, I can say from experience that ministry is what helps us grow as disciples. A faith that does not serve in love runs the risk of becoming shallow. A clear refusal to serve is clearly not becoming of our Baptismal call.

That being said, we must be willing to serve with a spirit of generosity and humility. Just as we do not have the right to walk into a stranger's home, ministry on behalf of the Church is a privileged responsibility that we simply cannot assume for ourselves. That is why, each year, we commission and bless those who represent our community in service during the Mass. We will be celebrating our commissioning Sunday on the weekend of September 29/30. I will invite you all to pray in order to prepare for this celebration.
