Is God as aware of and concerned about our gardening failures as we are?

When we judge ourselves as to what kind of soil we are, as per the Sower and the Seed parable, what we don't realize is that every single one of us is a conglomeration of every soil type and we all have areas where we feel arid, rootless and fruitless, areas that are thorny and areas where the soil is good and fruitful.

"Yeah, but I'm not fruitful like those other people. They seem so close to God all the time." What you see is the good soil fruit, on display for all to see. What you never see are the struggles in the hidden areas of soil that need tending. You, too, look like a bearer of good fruits to others, even when you can only see your own arid patches.

In the last part of the Sower and the Seed parable, Jesus says, "But as for what was sown on good soil, this is the one who hears the word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit and yields, in one case a hundred-fold, in another sixty and in another thirty."

Not everyone bears a hundred-fold all the time; thinking God expects that is a total misunderstanding of God. God has a completely different way of receiving our fruitfulness; comparisons and saintly high bars have no part of it. Remember the parable of the workers who started late and got paid as much as the ones who had been there all day? Don't make the mistake of thinking God is hung up on quantity. That's a human trait, not God's. He is absolutely into quality so if you produce only one small but nutritious fruit he will be delighted. He won't be saying, "Well, that's not much."

A warm smile is good fruit. A helping hand is sweet produce. One word of encouragement...oh my gosh! Worth more to God than someone who gives talks to a thousand people.

Don't judge yourself in a way God never would.
