The Dangers of Fish Sorting

This week's Gospel begins with treasure in a field and a pearl of great price and then it slides quickly into fishermen saving the good fish and throwing out the bad. Finally it crashes into what seems to be an apocalyptic description of angels separating the righteous from the evil. Fires, weeping and teeth gnashing are involved. If you remember last week's reflection, the fire will be the Fire of Love. Certainly, it will be painful in the moment to be utterly stripped of all our inner violence, our bad fish judgements and our inability to forgive as we have been forgiven. We use judgement and unforgiveness as a defensive device; they are our security. To be stripped of those will be excruciatingly devastating. We will weep and gnash our teeth but suddenly the burning will be gone and we will be left with only our true selves - and

In the parable last week, of the enemy sowing weeds amongst the wheat, the servants were not allowed to pull up the weeds because they might pull up the good with what they think is the bad. We human beings tend to do that very easily when it comes to other people, all the while feeling completely justified. But here's a sobering heads up: very soon after

teaching the parables of the last few weeks, Jesus would be judged by humans to be a weed, a bad fish, and an unrighteous one who must absolutely be torn up and thrown into the fire. All of us are usually totally bereft of wise discernment when it comes to judging others. We condemn individuals and whole groups of people and we believe God agrees with us. Anne LaMott wrote, "You can safely assume you have created God in your own image when it turns out that he hates all the same people you do."

Yet, in spite of our reluctance to let the bad fish of our judgements and unforgiveness go, our beautiful God still considers us to be pearls and treasures worth giving up everything for.

And he did give up everything for us.


