The Strong Man Defeated

When Jesus was asking the scribes how can Satan cast out Satan. I don't think they really understood his response to their accusations. The truth was, by trying to discredit Jesus and find ways to cast him out of popularity, the public scribes and Pharisees were dividing their own house. Satan is the father of violence and of violent

solutions and Jesus was tossing their accusations against him back in their faces. He was indicating that they were the ones who were possessed and were trying to cast out what they thought was possessed. Jesus was telling them that their kingdom was divided and could not stand. But they probably thought he was just engaging in semantics or quibbling with logic.

But then Jesus goes on to say that if you want to plunder the house of a strong man, you have to first tie the strong man up and then you can plunder his house. This is exactly what Jesus did on the cross. A kingdom of sacred violence (blood sacrifice) endeavoured to use violence to cast out what they thought was an unholy threat but Jesus, through suffering love (forbearing love) and forgiveness, entered into the strong man's house, tied him up and plundered it, meaning he released us all out of bondage. Note that Jesus, in today's Gospel, never said 'kill the strong man'; he just said 'tie him up'. Jesus never, ever, EVER resorts to violence as a solution. Love is his solution.

We may not ever engage in violent acts of the kind Jesus endured but from yelling at someone who is frustrating us to committing petty acts of revenge or giving someone the silent treatment, we engage in smaller acts of violence almost every day. Our little kingdoms are divided and are often on the verge of collapse. We need to reflect on how Jesus tied up the strong man through suffering love and forgiveness and realize once and for all...

...it's the only way.


If you would be willing to support a student on their international high school journey and experience, please consider welcoming an international students into your family. Host families receive \$1,275 per month to cover costs.
