The Cross and Us

"And just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that whoever trusts in him may have eternal life."

When the Israelites looked at the bronze serpent lifted up in the wilderness, they were looking at a reflection of the evil that was assailing them: venomous serpents that were biting and killing the Israelites.

When you look at a crucifix in your home or at church, do you just see Jesus suffering for us or do you also see a symbol (the bloody cross) of the evil of violence and scapegoating that is within all of us? All. Of. Us. The evil that nailed Jesus to the cross wasn't just part of an event that took place over 2000 years ago; the seeds of that evil reside in each one of us and we are all capable of violence and scapegoating. In fact, we do it all the time. Do you sometimes get angry at or yell at your spouse or at one of your children? That's violence. Do you ever see a problem and decide that one person is the cause of that problem and then try to make everyone else see it too? That's scapegoating. And that's just scratching the surface of our capacity for violence of the type that nailed Jesus to the cross.

Jesus's redemption of us should mean that when we look at him on the cross, we see an everlasting need for us to turn from violence and to resist scapegoating. We need to gaze at that cross and pray for the grace to turn away from raging at or pinning blame on others before we place someone else on a cross. If we aren't aware of how the cross should affect us every time we see it, we are trying to accept healing redemption without accepting our responsibility in the process. Jesus redeemed us so he could change in us what nailed him to the cross in the first place.

The Good News? The grace needed to do that is free.
