

When I write several reflections in a row as I often do, I start to see a theme running through the readings. Sunday's scripture is the 'Blessed are you who are... (poor, hungry, weeping, hated, excluded)" text and I have been writing about Jesus raising up those of lowly estate.

One thing that particularly struck me in this Gospel is at the beginning where it says that Jesus came down to a level place and stood looking up at a great crowd of his disciples. Looking up! In those days especially, kings and mighty men would situate themselves above the crowd. Yet Jesus happily and, it would seem, deliberately, placed himself in a lower place. He was not seeking to be mighty; he was not seeking kingship. He was lifting up the lowly as was foretold by Mary and Simeon.

"Blessed are you; holy are you," He wasn't just teaching them; he was honoring them. He was seeing them – really seeing them – as their true selves: wonderful and precious creations of God. Diamonds in the rough, you might say. He loved those of lowly estate so much.

He still does. And you've got to admit, even if you are well off or well educated, you are still a poor one. We are all poor, hungry, weeping and sometimes hated and excluded. Admitting your poverty and not clinging to the false security of status, success and wealth elevates you in the Kingdom of God. Jesus honors you, believes in you, knows your true worth and value and wants you to know your true worth as well.

What is your true estate? Blessed.





Feast of the Chair of St. Peter February 22

The Church celebrates the Feast of the Chair of St. Peter each year on February

Throughout the 2,000-year history of the Church, there have been 266 popes, beginning with Peter. Among them are many saints and martyrs who have devoted themselves to the Gospel.

The "chair" to which this feast refers is the cathedra, or office, of the Apostle Peter. Given by Christ to St. Peter (see Matthew 16:13-18),

Peter's supreme pastoral office is passed to each of his successors as Bishop of Rome, that is, where Peter last served and where he died a martyr. While an actual chair exists in Rome that some believe was used by St. Peter, the Chair of St. Peter represents the papacy, the unbroken succession of popes throughout the Church's 2,000-year history. Given by Christ Himself to St. Peter in the Gospel of Matthew, Chapter 16 verses 13-18, Peter's supreme pastoral office is passed to each of his successors as Bishop of Rome.



Peter himself was the longest-reigning pope, occupying his office from the year of Christ's death until sometime between 64 and 67 A.D. when he was martyred on Vatican Hill. Bl. Pius IX was his longest-reigning successor, his papacy lasting from 1846 to 1878. The second-longest-reigning successor was St. John Paul II (1978-2005).


