Welcome Fr. Shijo George

to Sacred Heart Parish!

We welcome, also, the Syro-Malabar Community back to the parish!

"The mustard shrub, which is considered a malignant weed, is extremely beneficial for the health. It grows entirely wild, though it is improved by being transplanted: but on the other hand, when it has once been sown, it is scarcely possible to



get the place free of it as the seed, when it falls, germinates at once. A real mustard plant is unlikely to attract nesting birds." (Natural historian Pliny the Elder, AD 78.)

Jesus's followers would have been aware of the characteristics of the Mustard Shrub. So what was Jesus saying when he compared the Kingdom of God to the Mustard seed? Considered malignant yet beneficial for the health? Improved by transplanting yet once sown, impossible to eradicate? Unlikely to attract nesting birds?

Perhaps Jesus wasn't trying to give a perfect analogy of the Kingdom but was, instead, letting his followers know that the Kingdom is a bunch of contradictions and something that can't be frozen into a single image, tied up with string, put on a shelf and forgotten. The Kingdom is dynamic and it organically responds to what is needed in the present moment. It is a mustard seed. It is yeast. It is a dead seed. It is abundant life. When you say it can't be this or do that, that's exactly what it can be and will do. It is invasive like a malignant weed yet it is beneficial for the health. It's not the first place birds will choose to build their nests yet it is always available for that. It begins tiny and ends up taking over.

With what shall we compare the Kingdom of God? It is the creative, loving energy of God doing whatever God wants, whenever he wants, however he wants.

It is a sheer and utter explosion of hope.

Fr. Shijo George

Fr. Shijo George (1985) was born in Tellichery, India, and is a priest of the Vincentian Congregation, ordained on 28 December 2011 by the Late Mar (or Most Reverend) Paul Chittilapilli.



He joined the Vincentian Minor Seminary in 2000 and completed his philosophical studies at De Paul Institute in Bangalore; Bachelor of Arts, Bangalore University; and Theological Studies at St. Joseph's Pontifical Seminary in Mangalapuzha.

Fr. Shijo holds a Masters of Arts in Christian Studies from Madras University, a Masters in Political Science (2017), and a certificate of Climate Studies from Harvard University (2020). He has held the position of Vice Rector, member of Popular Mission, and Finance Officer of the Vincentian Minor Seminaries in Kerala from 2012 to 2015. Thereafter, he was Assistant Director and Finance Officer of the Divine Prayer Centre in Mangalore; Pastor of St. Joseph Church, Aurangabad, under the Diocese of Shamshabad (2017 to 2020); Administrator of De Paul Public School in Kopargaon; and as Parish Priest of St. Thomas Church in Janakpuri in the Faridabad Diocese. His last assignment was as Associate Priest at St. Joseph the Worker Church here in Victoria. Fr. Shijo is also Pastor to the Syro-Malabar Catholics in the Diocese of Victoria. His hobbies are reading, listening to music, cooking, and trekking.

Eparchy of Mississauga

The Apostolic Exarchate for Syro-Malabar Catholics in Canada was elevated to the rank of an Eparchy with the title in Mississauga by His Holiness Pope Francis on 22 December 2018. The inauguration of the Eparchy and the installation of Mar (Bp) Jose Kalluvelil were solemnized on 25 May 2019 by His Beatitude George Cardinal Alencherry, Major Archbishop of the Syro-Malabar Catholic Church, at St. Alphonsa Syro-Malabar Catholic Cathedral, Mississauga.

Vincentian Congregation (VC)

The Vincentian Congregation is a clerical society within the Syro-Malabar Church with its Generalate at Edappally in the Archdiocese of Ernakulam-Angamaly, India. It comes under the category of the Societies of Common Life according to the manner of religious, and the Pontifical Right. The Congregation, founded on 20 November 1904 as a Koventha at Thottakom, India, by Fr. Varkey Kattarath with three diocesan priests, had the approval and encouragement of Mar Louis Pazheparampil, the first Vicar Apostolic of Ernakulam. The rule of the Koventha was based on the Common Rules of St. Vincent de Paul and on the model of the Congregation of the Mission founded by St. Vincent de Paul in 1625.

As I shared in my memo of May 24, 2024, Rev. Jan Grotkowski, S.D.S. was recently and unexpectedly called to a new assignment by his Religious Superior. After much prayer and discussion, the Diocese of Victoria Personnel Committee has discerned that Sacred Heart Parish, having experienced a number of changes over the past few years, is in great need of a period of stability.

Therefore, I announce today that Rev. Shijo George, new to the Diocese in December 2023, and here upon mutual agreement with the Eparchy of Mississauga, will be appointed Pastor of Sacred Heart Parish effective June 15, 2024. He will also continue to serve the Syro-Malabar faithful.

St. Andrew's High School International Student Program




